#### Notification

No. 2/1/2013-Fin(R&amp;C)/Part(A)/913

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-rule (4) of Rule 99 of the Goa Excise Duty Rules, 1964, the Government of Goa, being satisfied that it is necessary in the public interest, hereby directs that all licensed premises "for sale of liquor" and "consumption of liquor in public places" (hereinafter called said area) located within the jurisdiction of Pollem village of Canacona Taluka and Surla Village of Satari Taluka which falls within the range of 05 kms. from the border of Karwar and Belgavi, Karnataka shall be closed from 00.00 hrs. of 10th May, 2018 till midnight of 12th May, 2018, in view of General Election to Karnataka Legislative Assembly, 2018.

However, the licensed premises having licence for "Bar and Restaurant" may be allowed to keep the restaurant open for serving food only and the Bar counter shall be closed and no liquor shall be allowed to serve on the above mentioned days. The owners of the license premises having "Bar & Restaurant" shall also display a board in the licensed premises, stating that no liquor will be served and that the restaurant will be open for serving food only.

#### Notification

No. 2/1/2013-Fin(R&amp;C)/Part(B)/914

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 5 and 8 of the Goa Excise Duty Act & Rules, 1964 (Act 5 of 1964) (hereinafter called the "said Act"), the Government of Goa hereby prescribes that, notwithstanding anything contained in the Government Notifications No. 2/6/2014-Fin(R&C)/(A)/1386 dated 28-8-2014 and No. 2/6/2014-Fin(R&C)/(B)/1389 dated 28-8-2014, both published in the Official Gazette, Series II No. 22 dated 28-08-2014, the following shall be the maximum quantity of liquor which can be

transported from one place to another in the range of 05 kms. from the border of Karwar and Belgavi Districts of Karnataka State, within the jurisdiction of Pollem Village of Canacona Taluka and Surla Village of Satari Taluka of Goa respectively, by any person or which can be possessed by any person within the said areas, without a permit issued in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and the rules made thereunder, from 00.00 hrs. of 10th May, 2018 till midnight of 12th May, 2018, in view of General Election to Karnataka Legislative Assembly, 2018:—

(a) Three quart bottles of Indian made foreign liquor or foreign liquor other than beer and six bottles of 650 ml. of beer for any person including his family.

(b) Three quart bottles of country liquor for any person including his family.

This Notification shall remain in force only from 00.00 hrs. of 10th May, 2018 till midnight of 12th May, 2018, in view of General Election for Karnataka Legislative Assembly, 2018.
