Under Section 144(1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1973

Whereas, a report has been received from the Superintendent of Police, North Goa, vide Nos. SP/North/Reader/2960/2017 dated 22-11-2017, inter-alia, stating that the a FIR No. 111/2017 u/s 153(a), 295(a) and 506 IPC dated 2nd July, 2017 has been registered at High Grounds Police Station, Bengaluru, Karnataka against Mr. Pramod Muthalik for hate speech which have hurt the sentiments of a specific community and in which she has stated that he and his supporters would spill blood if any Iftar party or Namaz was allowed in any temple henceforth. This could adversely affect peace, harmony and create fear in the minds of the public and tourists;

And whereas, after having carefully examined the material put forth by the Superintendent of Police,

I am satisfied that there are sufficient grounds for proceeding under Section 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 to prevent the entry of the associates and members of "Sri Ram Sene", and its leader, Shri Pramod Muthalik into the jurisdiction of North Goa District as there is every possibility of disturbance to law and order and danger to public safety due to their aggressive statements or speeches that could hurt the sentiments of certain groups of the public and instigate violence, thus adversely affecting public peace and tranquility;

And whereas, the circumstances do not allow the serving of notice individually.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me under Section 144(1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, I, Nila Mohanan, IAS, District Magistrate, North Goa, do hereby ban the entry of Shri Pramod Mutalik, son of Hanumant Rao Mutalik, leader of "Sri Ram Sene" and any of his associates or members within the jurisdiction of the North Goa District for a period of 60 days with effect from 15-05-2018.
