No. 2/1/95-Fin(R&C)/Part(A)/2673

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-rule (4) of Rule 99 of the Goa Excise Duty Rules, 1964, the Government of Goa, being satisfied that it is necessary in the public interest, hereby directs that all licensed premises "for the sale of liquor" located within the jurisdiction of Pollem and Loliem village of Canacona Taluka and Surla village of Satari Taluka which falls within the range of 05 kms. from the border of Karwar and Belgavi, Karnataka shall be closed from 6.00 p.m. on 16 April, 2019 until 6.00 p.m. of 18th April, 2019 and from 6.00 p.m. on 21st April, 2019 until 6.00 p.m. of 23rd April, 2019 and day of counting on 23rd May, 2019, in view of General Election to Lok Sabha, 2019 in the State of Karnataka.

The licensed premises having licence for "Bar and Restaurant" may be allowed to keep the restaurant open for serving food only. However, the Bar counter shall be closed and no liquor shall be allowed to be served on the above mentioned days. The owners of the license premises having "Bar & Restaurant" shall also display a board in the licenced premises, stating that no liquor will be

served and that the restaurant will be open for serving food only.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 5 and 8 of the Goa Excise Duty Act & Rules, 1964 (Act 5 of 1964) (hereinafter called the "said Act"), the Government of Goa hereby prescribes that, notwithstanding anything contained in the Government Notifications No. 2/6/2014-Fin(R&C)/(A)/1386 dated 28-8-2014 and No. 2/6/2014-Fin(R&C)/(B)/1389 dated 28-8-2014, both published in the Official Gazette, Series II No. 22 dated 28-08-2014, the following shall be the maximum quantity of liquor which can be transported from one place to another in the range of 05 kms. from the border of Karwar and Belgavi District of Karnataka State, within the jurisdiction of Pollem and Loliem of Canacona Taluka and Surla Village of Satari Taluka of Goa respectively, by any person or which can be possessed by any person within the said areas of the border without a permit issued in accordance with the provision of said Act and the Rules made thereunder, shall be closed from 6.00 p.m. on 16th April, 2019 until 6.00 p.m. of 18th April, 2019 and from 6.00 p.m. on 21st April, 2019 until 6.00 p.m. of 23rd April, 2019 and day of counting on 23rd May, 2019, in view of General Election to Lok Sabha, 2019 in the State of Karnataka.

(a) Three quart bottles of Indian made foreign liquor or foreign liquor other than beer and six bottles of 650 ml. of beer for any person including his family.

(b) Three quart bottles of country liquor for any person including his family.

This Notification shall remain in force only from 6.00 p.m. on 16th April, 2019 until 6.00 p.m. of 18th April, 2019 and from 6.00 p.m. on 21st April, 2019 until 6.00 p.m. of 23rd April, 2019, in view of General Election to Lok Sabha, 2019 in the State of Karnataka.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 5 and 8 of the Goa Excise Duty Act & Rules, 1964 (Act 5 of 1964) (hereinafter called the “said Act”), the Government of Goa hereby prescribes that, notwithstanding anything contained in the Government Notifications No. 2/6/2014-Fin(R&C)/(A)/1386 dated 28-8-2014 and No. 2/6/2014-Fin(R&C)/(B)/1389 dated 28-8-2014, both published in the Official Gazette, Series II No. 22 dated 28-08-2014, no liquor shall be transported from one place to another within the State of Goa and the following shall be the maximum quantity of liquor which can be possessed by any person within the State of Goa without a permit issued in accordance with the provisions of said Act and the Rules made thereunder, during the period from 6.00 p.m. on 21st April, 2019 till 23rd April, 2019 and the day of counting on 23rd May, 2019, in view of General Election to Lok Sabha, 2019 and Bye-election, Goa State.

(a) Three quart bottles of Indian made foreign liquor or foreign liquor other than beer and six bottles of 650 ml. of beer for any person including his family.

(b) Three quart bottles of country liquor for any person including his family.

This Notification shall remain in force only from 6.00 p.m. of 21st April, 2019 till 23rd April, 2019 and the day of counting on 23rd May, 2019, in view of General Election to Lok Sabha, 2019 and Bye-election, Goa State.
