In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the Government Notification No. 1/37/74-PER (Part) dated 06-05-1993 and the Government Notification No. 1/37/74-PER (Part) dated 03-07-1984, published in the Official Gazette Series I No. 8 dated 20-05-1993 and the Official Gazette Series I No. 15 dated 12-07-1984 respectively, the Governor of Goa hereby makes the following rules to regulate the recruitment to the Goa General Service, Group 'A' and 'B', Gazetted, Non-Ministerial

posts, in the Directorate of Transport, Government of Goa, namely:—

1. *Short title, application and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Goa, Directorate of Transport, Group 'A' and 'B', Gazetted, Non-Ministerial posts, Recruitment Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall apply to the post specified in column (2) of the Schedule to these rules (hereinafter called as the "said Schedule").

(3) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Number, classification and the level in the pay matrix.*— The number of posts, classification of the said posts and the level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (3) to (5) of the said Schedule:

Provided that the Government may vary the number of posts as specified in column (3) of the said Schedule from time to time subject to exigencies of work.

3. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.*— The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (6) to (14) of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualification.*— No person who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted

a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the service:

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where, the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Goa Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for scheduled castes, scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in that regard.

These rules are issued in consultation with the Goa Public Service Commission conveyed vide their letter No. COM/II/13/49(1)/2019/1269 dated 06-03-2019 and Letter No. COM/II/13/49(1)/2019/1355 dated 25-03-2019.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with Section 21 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 (Central Act 10 of 1897), the Governor of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to further amend the Goa Governor's Secretariat (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2010, published vide Notification No. 1/3/88-PER (PF II) dated 08-04-2010, in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 3, dated 15-04-2010, as follows, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Governor's Secretariat (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) (Third Amendment) Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall come into force the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Amendment of rule 2.*— In the Goa Governor's Secretariat (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2010 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Rules"), in rule 2, for clause (b), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:- "(b) "Board" means the Board consisting of the Governor, Secretary to the Governor and Special Secretary/

/Additional Secretary/Joint Secretary to the Governor."

3. *Amendment of rule 5.*— In rule 5 of the principal Rules, for sub-rule (3), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

"(3) Wherever the composition of the Departmental Promotion Committee/Departmental Selection Committee is not specifically mentioned in these Rules, the same may be considered as Secretary to the Governor (Chairman), Special Secretary/Additional Secretary/Joint Secretary to the Governor (Member) and Under Secretary (General Administration Department) (Member)."

4. *Amendment of rule 6.*— In rule 6 of the principal Rules, for sub-rule (1), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

"(1) The Special Secretary/Additional Secretary/Joint Secretary to the Governor shall cause the agenda to be prepared for the intended purpose which shall be discussed in a meeting of a "Board". However, in the alternative, the agenda/proposal can also be approved/decided by circulation amongst the Board members."

5. *Amendment of Schedule-I.*— In Schedule I to the principal Rules, in column (13), for the words "Special Secretary", wherever they occur, the words and figure "Special Secretary/Additional Secretary/Joint Secretary" shall be substituted.

6. *Amendment of Schedule-II.*— In Schedule-II to the principal Rules, in column (13), for the words "Special Secretary", wherever they occur, the words and figure "Special Secretary/Additional Secretary/Joint Secretary" shall be substituted.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the existing Recruitment Rules notified vide Government Notification No. 1/6/78-PER (Vol. IV) P.F.I dated 29-01-2010, for the post of Gym Instructor, in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 46 dated 11-02-2010, the Governor of Goa hereby makes the following rules to regulate the recruitment to the Group 'C', Non-Ministerial, Non-Gazetted post, in the Directorate of Sports and Youth Affaris, Government of Goa, namely:—

1. *Short title, application and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Goa, Directorate of Sports and Youth Affairs, Group 'C' Non-Ministerial, Non-Gazetted post, Recruitment Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall apply to the post specified in column (1) of the Schedule to these rules (hereinafter called as the "said Schedule").

(3) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Number, classification and the level in the pay matrix.*— The number of posts, classification of the said post and the level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule:

Provided that the Government may vary the number of posts as specified in column (2) of the said Schedule from time to time subject to exigencies of work.
