In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 5 and 8 of the Goa Excise Duty Act, 1964 (Act 5 of 1964) (hereinafter called the "said Act"), the Government of Goa hereby prescribed that, notwithstanding anything contained in the Government Notifications No. Fin(Rev.)/2-35/SE/6/68/(A) dated 29-2-1972 and No. Fin(Rev.)/2-35/SE/6/65/(B) dated 29-2-1972, the following shall be the maximum quantity of liquor which can be transported from one place to another within the jurisdiction of the Village Panchayat as specified in column (3) of the Schedule hereto, (hereinafter called "the said area"), located in the Taluka as specified in column (2) of the said Schedule, or which can be possessed by any person within the said area, without permit issued in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and the rules made thereunder, from 09-04-2011 to 11-04-2011.

Whereas the Government of Goa is of the opinion that an industrial dispute exists between the management of M/s. Starflex Sealing India Private Limited, Verna-Goa and it's Workmen represented by the Goa Trade and Commercial Workers Union, in respect of the matter specified in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as the "said dispute");

And whereas the Government of Goa considers it expedient to refer the said dispute for adjudication.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (Central Act 14 of 1947) (hereinafter referred to as the "said Act"), the Government of Goa hereby refers the said dispute for adjudication to the Industrial Tribunal of Goa at Panaji-Goa, constituted under Section 7-A of the said Act.

**Demand No. 1: Pay Scales and Flat-Rise**

It is demanded that workers be paid a Flat-Rise in their existing basic salary with effect from

01-12-2007 @ Rs. 1,000/- per month and be fitted in the grades and pay scales given below as per their respective grade and nature of work.

#### **Demand No. 2: Fixed Dearness Allowance**

It is demanded that, with effect from 01-12-2007, every Workman be paid Fixed Dearness Allowance (FDA) of Rs. 1,000/- per month.

#### **Demand No. 3: Variable Dearness Allowance**

It is demanded that, with effect from 01-12-2007, each Workman be paid a Variable Dearness Allowance (VDA) at the revised rate of Rs. 2/- per point at base AAICPI 2000 points (1960=100), to be revised every quarter.

#### **Demand No. 4: Seniority Increments**

It is demanded that the Workmen should be given Seniority Increments as mentioned below:—

Service upto 5 years : Two Increments  
Service above 5 years : Three Increments

#### **Demand No. 5: House Rent Allowance**

It is demanded that, with effect from 01-12-2007, each Workman be paid House Rent Allowance (HRA) @ 20% of the basic pay plus Fixed Dearness Allowance and Variable Dearness Allowance, each month.

#### **Demand No. 6: Conveyance Allowance**

It is demanded that, with effect from 01-12-2007, all Workmen be paid Conveyance Allowance by adding Rs. 300/- per Workman per month.

#### **Demand No. 7: Paid Holidays**

It is demanded that all the workpersons be granted at least fourteen days Paid Holidays every year. It is further demanded that the festival holidays

that fall on Sundays shall be changed to next day or one day earlier, which shall be finalized in consultation with the Union/Committee.

#### **Demand No. 8: Leave Facility**

It is demanded that the workperson be made eligible to the following Leave Facilities with effect from 01-12-2007.

- a) *Earned Leave* : All the Workmen be given Earned Leave at the rate of 30 days per year with accumulation upto 120 days and leave shall be allowed to be taken 5 times in a year.
- b) *Casual Leave* : All the Workmen be given Casual Leave at the rate of 10 days per year.
- c) *Sick Leave* : All the Workmen should be given Sick Leave at the rate of 15 days per year to be accumulated upto 60 days.

#### **Demand No. 9: Leave Travel Allowance**

It is demanded that, with effect from 01-12-2007, the workpersons be paid Leave Travel Allowance @ Rs. 5,000/- per annum with minimum of four days earned leave. The amount shall be paid one week before the commencement of leave.

#### **Demand No. 10: Loan**

It is demanded that interest free Loan of Rs. 50,000/- be granted to every Workman for house repairs and to meet the expenses towards the purchase of house hold articles or scooter or marriage of self or of his/her family member, etc. which shall be recoverable in 60 equal installments.

#### **Demand No. 11: Bonus/Ex-Gratia**

It is demanded that all the workpersons be paid Bonus/Ex-Gratia at the rate of 20% of gross wages every year i.e. 2007-08 onwards, before the festival of Deepavali.

#### **Demand No. 12: Festival Allowance**

It is demanded that all the workpersons be paid a Festival Advance once in a year for any festival @ Rs. 3,000/- each to be deducted in 6 equal installments.

#### **Demand No. 13: Promotion Policy**

It is demanded that separate Promotion Policy be promulgated in consultation with the Union.

#### **Demand No. 14: Period of Settlement**

It is demanded that the Period of Settlement be three years i.e. from 01-12-2007 to 30-11-2010.
