DCS/ENF/NFSA-Rules/19-20/165

Whereas, the draft rules, namely, Goa Food Security (Grievance Redressal Mechanism, Transparency and Accountability) (First Amendment) Rules, 2019 which the Government of Goa proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 40 of the National Food Security Act, 2013 (Central Act 20 of 2013) so as to amend Goa Food Security (Grievance Redressal Mechanism, Transparency and Accountability) Rules, 2017, were published as required by sub-section (1) of section 40 of the said Act, vide Notification No. DCS/ENF/NFSA-Rules/2019-20/87 dated 4th

July, 2019 of Department of Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 15, dated 11th July, 2019, inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby within a period of 30 days from the date of publication of the said Notification in the Official Gazette;

And whereas, the said Official Gazette was made available to the public on 11th July, 2019;

And whereas, no objections and suggestions have been received from the public on the said draft Rules by the Government within the stipulated period.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 40 of the National Food Security Act, 2013 (Central Act No. 20 of 2013) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to amend the Goa Food

Security (Grievance Redressal Mechanism, Transparency and Accountability) Rules, 2017, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Food Security (Grievance Redressal Mechanism, Transparency and Accountability) (First Amendment) Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Amendment of rule 16.*— In rule 16 of the Goa Food Security (Grievance Redressal Mechanism, Transparency and Accountability) Rules, 2017,—

(i) in sub-rule (1), for clauses (I) and (II), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:—

“(I) *At State Level.*— The Minister for Civil Supplies shall be the Chairperson of the State Level Vigilance Committee and there shall be minimum seven other members on said committee, namely, three elected representatives from the local authorities, one woman, one person belonging to Scheduled Caste, one person belonging to Scheduled Tribe and one person with disability or a destitute person;

(II) *At District Level.*— The Collector of the District shall be the Chairperson of respective District Level Vigilance Committee and there shall be minimum six other members on said committee, namely, two elected representatives from the local authorities, one woman, one person belonging to Scheduled Caste, one person belonging to Scheduled Tribe, one person with disability or a destitute person;

(ii) for sub-rule (2), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“(2) The Vigilance Committees shall meet atleast once in a quarter. The date, time and place of the meeting shall be as fixed by the Chairperson. Action taken on the issues discussed in the prior meeting

shall be reviewed in the next meeting of the Vigilance Committee.”;

(iii) sub-rules (3) and (4) shall be omitted;

(iv) sub-rules (5) and (6) shall be renumbered as sub-rules (3) and (4) respectively.

The following draft rules which the Government of Goa proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 read with sections 33, 34, 35, 39, 46 and 47 of the Indian Ports Act, 1908 (Central Act 15 of 1908) (hereinafter referred to as the "said Act") so as to further amend the Goa Ports Rules, 1983 are hereby pre-published as required by sub-section (2) of section 6 of the said Act, for information of all the persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said rules will be taken into consideration by the Government after expiry of a period of fifteen days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.

All objections and/or suggestions to the said draft rules may be forwarded to the Captain of Ports and ex officio Joint Secretary to the Government of Goa, Captain of Ports Department, Panaji, before the expiry of the said period of fifteen days so that they may be taken into consideration at the time of finalization of the said draft rules.

DRAFT RULES

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 read with sections 33, 34, 35, 39, 46 and 47 of the Indian Ports Act, 1908 (Central Act 15 of 1908), and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as

to further amend the Goa Ports Rules, 1983, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Ports (Amendment) Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Amendment of rule 2.*— In rule 2 of the Goa Ports Rules, 1983 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Rules"), for clause (i), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

(i) "Port Authority" means the Captain of Ports, the Deputy Captain of Ports and Marine Engineer & Ship Surveyor of Captain of Ports Department.

3. *Amendment of rule 15.*— In rule 15 of the principal Rules,—

(i) for sub-rule (2), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

"(2) An application for licence may be made to Port Authority in Form No. I, alongwith craft documents, drawings for examination and inspection and measurement fees as specified in Schedule I hereto".

(ii) for sub-rule (3), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

"(3) On receipt of an application for licence, the Port Authority shall scrutinize craft documents and drawings and thereafter shall inspect the craft or cause it to be inspected and on being satisfied that the craft is seaworthy, properly equipped and suited for the service for which it is proposed, issue a registration number to the craft after completion of registration formalities and thereafter issue a licence in Form No. II, on payment of annual licence fees and Examination/approval fees as specified in the Schedule I hereto.

4. *Amendment of Schedule-I.*— In Schedule-I appended to the principal Rules,—

(i) in item 1, for clause (a), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(a) inland non-mechanized craft,—

(i) Upto 2.00 tons,—Rs. 500.00 per annum

(ii) Above 2.00 tons and upto 5.00 tons,—Rs. 600.00 per annum

(iii) Above 5.00 tons and upto 10.00 tons,—Rs. 800.00 per annum

(iv) Above 10.00 tons and upto 25.00 tons,—Rs. 1,000.00 per annum

(v) Above 25.00 tons,—

(A) First 25 tons,—Rs. 100.00 per annum

(B) Every additional 20.00 tons,—Rs. 25.00”; per annum

(ii) for clause (b), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(b) Inland mechanized/non-mechanized cargo and passenger craft—Double the rate specified in 1 (a) above.

(iii) in item 1 and 4, “Note” therein shall be omitted;

(iv) in item 13, for the expression “Rs. 5.00”, the expression “Rs. 500.00” shall be substituted;

(v) in item 17, for clauses (i) to (iii), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:—

(i) For inspection of non-mechanized craft—Each Rs. 1,000.00

(ii) For inspection of mechanized craft—Each Rs. 1,500.00

(vi) in item 18, for expression “Rs. 100.00”, the expression “Rs.500/-” shall be substituted;

(vii) in item 19, for clauses (i) to (iii), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:—

(i) For measurement of non-mechanized craft—Rs. 1,000.00

(ii) For measurement of mechanized craft—Rs. 1,500.00

(viii) after item 56, the following items shall be inserted, namely:—

(57) Fees for Examination/Approval of the structural and General Arrangement plan/drawings of the craft for inland mechanized and non-mechanized passenger/cargo:—

(i) Scantling (General Arrangement)—Rs. 4,000.00

(ii) Safety Plan—Rs. 3,000.00

(iii) Structural details (Plan)—Rs. 3,000.00

(iv) Any other plan not covered above—Rs. 3,000.00

(58) Fees for effecting transfer of ownership of licence of the non-mechanized craft to another person upto 25.00 tons—Rs. 1000.00 and for mechanized craft to another person upto 25.00 tons—Rs. 2000.00.”
