scheme vide Notification No. CEE/Accts./357/OTS/2020-21/69/2022, dated 01-01-2020, in order to enable prompt recovery of such outstanding.

Further, the Government of Goa is also pleased to grant 50% relief on the outstanding amount of the old Permanently Disconnected consumers as on 10-10-2020, wherein the segregation of principal amount and Delayed Payment Charges (DPC) are not available in the records of the Department and entire amount has been treated as principal amount in OTSS-2020.
