In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section 3(A) of section 12 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 (Central Act 6 of 1974); and in supersession of notification No. 5/20/87-STE/DIR/Part VII/1030 dated 11-12-2020 read at 2 above, the Goa State Pollution Control Board (GSPCB),

with the approval of the Government of Goa; hereby makes the following amendment rules so as to regulate the recruitment to various technical and non technical posts in the Goa State Pollution Control Board, namely:—

1. *Short title, application and commencement.*— (i) These rules may be called the Goa State Pollution Control Board, Group 'A', 'B', 'C' and 'D' posts, Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2020 (hereinafter referred to as 'these rules').

(iii) they shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Amendment to Schedule to the Goa State Pollution Control Board, Group 'A', 'B', 'C' and 'D' posts, Recruitment Rules, 2020.*— (1) In Serial No. 2 in column No. 12, the existing expression "Promotion of Assistant Environmental Engineer for the Board with atleast 5 years service in the grade/holding analogous position for at least 5 years in the grade", shall be substituted by new expression "Promotion of Assistant Environmental Engineer of the Board with atleast 5 years service in the grade/holding analogous position/for at least 5 years in the grade. OR Masters Degree in Environmental Engineering/Public Health Engineering from a recognized University/Institution having experience of atleast 3 years in pollution control or in related subject".

(2) In Serial No. 3 in column No. 8, the existing expression "Degree in Civil Engineering/Mechanical Engineering/Environmental Engineering or equivalent from a recognised University/Institution and experience in pollution control or related subjects. (2) Atleast 7 years experience in pollution control or related subject. Knowledge of Konkani. Desirable: (1) M. Tech in Environmental Engineering (2) Knowledge of Marathi" shall be substituted with new expression "N. A."

(3) In Serial No. 4 in column No. 8, the existing expression "Essential: (1) Degree in Engineering (Civil)/Mechanical/Environment from a recognised University/Institution.

(2) At least four years working experience in industrial pollution control measures and knowledge of Environmental Rules and Acts in a Government undertaking, registered societies/or in any other reputed organisation. (3) Knowledge of Konkani (4) M. Tech in Environmental Engineering, Desirable: (1) Knowledge of Marathi." shall be substituted with new expression "Essential: (1) Degree in Engineering (Chemical/Civil)/Mechanical/Environment from a recognised University/Institution. (2) At least Four years working experience in industrial pollution control measures and knowledge of Environmental Rules and Acts in a Government undertaking, registered societies/or in any other reputed organisation. (3) Knowledge of Konkani Desirable.: (1) Knowledge of Marathi (2) M. Tech in Environmental Engineering."

(4) In Serial No. 5 in column 3 the expression "(04) four" shall be substituted with new expression "(03) Three".

(5) In Serial No. 7 in column 7 and 8, the existing expression "Not exceeding 40 years (relaxable for Government servants/working in Government institutions/recognised Government undertaking/Registered Societies upto 5 years)" and "Essential: (1) Masters Degree in Chemistry/any branch of Environmental Science from a recognised University/Institution with at least 12 years experience in pollution control or related field in Government organisation or in other reputed Organisation/Institution OR Doctorate in any of the above subjects and possessing at least 12 years experience in pollution control or related field in a Government or in any other reputed organisation. (2) Knowledge of Konkani Desirable: Knowledge of Marathi" shall be substituted with the expression "N.A."

(6) In Serial No. 8. for column 11, for the expression "By promotion" shall be substituted with the expression "Promotion of Scientist 'B' with atleast 5 years experience."

(3) Knowledge of Konkani" shall be substituted with the expression "Essential: (1) Bachelors Degree in Law from a recognised University (2) At least 8 years working experience in Legal Department of Govt./Govt. undertaking/Institution/Autonomous Body dealing with Environment Acts. (3) Knowledge of Konkani".

(14) In Serial No. 20 in column 9, the expression "N.A." shall be substituted with the expression "Age No. Qualifications: To the extent indicated in column No. 12".

In the above read notification, the following sub-clause may be inserted after clause 5 (iv), so as to amend the scheme, notified vide above read notification, published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 5 dated 30-04-2020.

"5 (v) Guidelines of the Scheme:—

a) The Headmaster/Principal of the institution should ensure selection of students of Standard 8th, 9th or 10th of their respective High Schools. To be eligible, minimum marks obtained in Science subject should be 50% for ST category and 75% for General category for the last 2 academic years. The ST Students to be selected based on ST certificate issued by Competent Authority.

b) Selection for Higher Secondary students shall be based on marks obtained in previous academic year i.e. either Standard 10th or Standard 11th with minimum of 50% for ST and 75% for General category. Only students from Science stream shall be eligible.

c) Schools have the choice to select an Institution of Excellence of their interest in the field of Science and Technology within the Country for such visit.

d) A group can have maximum of 5 students and 1 teacher of the same School/Higher Secondary or combination of multiple Schools/Higher Secondaries of the same taluka. In the event a group comprises of more than one School/Higher Secondary Grant in Aid shall be given to the applicant School/Higher Secondary which shall manage the amount for the entire group. It may be noted that maximum of 10 such groups are entitled to avail the benefit per year under the scheme.

e) A group must have minimum 2 students belonging to ST category.

f) If the group has even one girl child, then the accompanying teacher must be female.

g) An amount of Rs. 50,000/- to each group of students/teachers shall be provided per trip. A School can avail the benefit of the scheme once a year.

h) Wherever, possible and available Government accommodation should be used for the visiting students/teachers and travel mode shall be railway, bus etc.

i) The School shall apply in Form I appended to the Scheme preferably 2 months prior to the visit.

The Government of Goa is pleased to notify the scheme after modification titled as “The Goa State Interim Compensation to Road Accident Victims, 2020”, which was earlier titled as “The Goa State Interim Compensation to Road Accident Victims, 2015”.

Preamble.— Increase in number of vehicles results in traffic congestion and consequentially in road accidents. While Government does its best to minimize if not eliminate, some tragic accidents are inevitable. Every year an approximately 250-300 people lose their lives and large number are injured, some with permanent disability and others with partial disability and more often than not, the deceased/injured happen to be the only bread earner of the family and not covered by any life insurance cover and in the event of death and disability of such persons, the entire family is disturbed emotionally, psychologically and financially.

And whereas Government has proposed to provide such families Financial Assistance irrespective of insurance cover enjoyed by the victim.

And in order to fulfill the given assurance as well as for effective implementation of the assurance, the Government was pleased to enact a scheme.

And whereas it has been observed that the Existing Scheme is not meeting the expected results due to the cumbersome process in general and provision regarding Insurance coverage of any nature disqualifying the beneficiary in specific, and therefore in view of the above, the Existing Scheme is modified to that extent.

And therefore to make it simple and flexible so as to meet the desired results i.e. for immediate monetary help to road accidents victims, the scheme is modified as under:—

(1) *Title.*— The scheme shall be called “the Goa State Interim Compensation to Road Accident Victims, 2020”.

(2) *Commencement.*— It shall come into force from the date of publication in Official Gazette and shall be valid for five years from the date of its notification.

(3) *Definitions.*— In this scheme, unless there is anything repugnant to the subject or context—

(i) *Beneficiary.*— “Beneficiary” means the person entitled to receive the compensation/financial assistance paid under the scheme. For the purpose of this scheme entitlement of beneficiary to the sum of compensation shall be in order of priority as under:—

(i) In case of Death of the person/victim of road accident his/her:— (i) spouse (ii) son(s) and unmarried daughter(s) (divided equally) (iii) parents of the victim (iv) unmarried brother(s) and sister(s).

(ii) In case of permanent injury (i) victim or in case he is unable to avail the benefit himself (ii) his/her spouse (iii) daughter(s)/son(s)/mother/father.

In case of any dispute with respect to the proportion of amount of compensation, the decision of the Director (Transport) shall be final.

(ii) *Death.*— “Death” means a death on account of an accident on the spot or within 12 months of accident on account of any injury suffered during the accident provided it be the sole and direct cause of the death as certified by Registered Medical Practitioner.

(iii) *Family.*— The term family shall include spouse of the victim, son(s), unmarried daughter(s), mother and father, unmarried brother(s) and sister(s).

(iv) *Permanent injury*:— “Permanent injury” means an injury that results in victim not able to carry on any business or occupation as he was carrying on before the accident and so certified by Superintendent, Goa Medical College or Director of Health Services or their designated officials for the purpose of the scheme.

(v) *Victim*:— “Victim” for purpose of short term relief means “any person who dies in road accident within the State of Goa irrespective of domicile” and for long term relief means “any person who has suffered injury requiring hospitalization having (15) fifteen years of permanent residence in the State of Goa.

(4) *Scope of the Scheme*.— The Scheme provides for financial assistance to the victims/families of victims against accidental death or bodily injury caused by external, violent visible means in road accidents.

(5) *The Scheme shall provide for*:—

(I) *Short Term Reliefs*: (a) In case of Death on road/In case of Death in Hospital/any other place but where cause of death attributable to the accident-Upfront (financial assistance) payment of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) based on the application as per Annexure 'A' made to the Director of Transport by the member of the family of the victim. The payment of financial assistance to be made in the following order:—

- (i) Spouse of the victim.
- (ii) Daughter(s).
- (iii) Son(s).
- (iv) Mother.
- (v) Father.

The above payment is to be made without verification of any other conditions. The compensation shall be paid as per clause (7) below.

(b) In case of any serious injury suffered in road accident and the injured requiring

hospitalization of more than 07 days period – an immediate payment of compensation of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) based on the application as per Annexure 'A' made to the Director of Transport by the victim or any member of the family of the injured. The payment of the financial assistance to be made in the following order:—

- (i) Spouse of the victim.
- (ii) Daughter(s).
- (iii) Son(s).
- (iv) Mother.
- (v) Father.

The above payment is to be made without verification of any other conditions. The Compensation shall be paid as per clause (7) below.

(II) *Long Term Reliefs*: The long term reliefs shall be applicable to those, whose family income i.e. cumulative income of spouse/daughter(s)/son(s) after the accident is less than 3.00 lakhs and the same shall be paid as per clause (7) after deducting any compensation already paid under clause (I) above i.e. under Short Term Relief.

- (a) Rs. 2.00 lakhs in case of death;
- (b) Rs. 1.50 lakhs in case of Permanent injury;
- (c) Rs. 1.00 lakh in case of serious/permanent injury not leading to loss of job/occupation but where hospitalization exceeds 60 days immediately after accident;
- (d) Rs. 50,000/- in case of injuries other than specified above but requires hospitalisation upto 60 days after but exceeding 7 days;
- (e) Rs. 10,000/- in case of injuries requiring 3 to 7 days of hospitalisation.

(6) The scheme provides for disbursement of compensation to the families of Road

Accident Victims by the Transport Department on the basis of procedure as at Annexure 'A', 'B' and 'C'.

(7) The payment of compensation shall be made as under:—

(i) In case of death:

(a) Surviving spouse;

(b) In absence of (a) above, the amount of compensation to be divided equally amongst the son(s) and unmarried daughter(s).

(c) In absence of (a) and (b), parents;

(d) In case of absence of (a), (b), (c), unmarried brother(s)/sister(s).

(e) In case of absence of (a), (b), (c) and (d) then no compensation shall be paid.

(ii) In case of permanent injury:

(a) To the survivor.

(b) To any other relation as indicated in clause 7 (i) above, in order as indicated in case the survivor is not medically in condition to avail the same.

(8) *Procedure for claiming the compensation.* — (a) Upon the happening of any event which may give rise to a claim under this scheme, an application in the prescribed proforma with full particulars must be submitted online on the Department website goatransport.gov.in or manually to the Director, Directorate of Transport within a period of 180 days of the happening of such event for Long Term Relief and within 30 days for Short Term Relief.

(b) Documentary/Satisfactory proof upon which a claim is based, shall be furnished to the Government along with the claim.

(c) Medical Officer or other authorized person of the Government shall be allowed to examine the injured person(s) to verify the nature of alleged injury or disablement if it is reasonably required by the Department for finalization of the claim.

(d) No relaxation for payment to any person including legal heirs.

(e) No relaxation in time period for application.

(9) *Procedure for disbursement.*— Compensation under this scheme shall be disbursed by the Directorate of Transport, 1st Floor, Junta House, Panaji-Goa.

(10) *Applicability.*— (a) To any victim in the State of Goa for Short Term Relief.

(b) To any victim with 15 years of Residence in the State of Goa for Long Term Relief.

(11) The modified scheme shall be applicable to all cases on or after 19-06-2015.

(12) This compensation paid is not insurance but it is a compassionate payment by State Government to overcome plight faced by the victim and his family due to trauma and expenses incurred. It is not right of any one and it is totally at the discretion of Government and subject to budgetary provision.

(13) The said compensation paid is not subject to any deductions by insurance company (Refer Clause 12).

(14) *Constitution of the Screening Committee.*— The Screening Committee shall consist of the following Members:-

1. Director of Transport	Chairman.
2. Deputy Director of Transport, North, Panaji	Member.
3. Deputy Director of Transport, South, Margao	Member.
4. Accounts Officer	Member Secretary.

7. EPIC Card or Aadhaar Card or PAN Card or any other Bank Passbook with Photo or any other Photo Identity issued by State or Central Government Authority.
8. Income Certificate if there are dependants on the claimant.
9. Marriage Certificate in case of the claimant is surviving spouse. Wherever such document is not available, Birth Certificate of the child showing name of father and mother.
10. In case of legal heirs of victim (other than spouse), documents in support of the same and NOC from brother(s)/sisters(s).

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
