Short title and commencement.— The scheme shall be called “Promotion of Mechanization in Agriculture.”

Read Notification:- No. 3/1/AD(AE)/2017-18/D.Agri/120 dated 7-9-2017 Series 1 No. 23.

Amendment

The condition No. 3(iv) of Pattern of Assistance in the above referred Notification is as amended below:—

“Individual farmer, groups, registered farmer societies, farmers club etc. will be able to purchase machine or equipments by availing “At Source subsidy facility”. In such cases, the subsidy shall be paid to the dealer provided farmer pays his/her share of cost (cost price-subsidy) to the dealer and also furnishes Letter of Authority to that effect. All such cases shall require prior approval of Director of Agriculture.

Other contents of the Notification remains the same.

The Dearness Relief @ 28% is to be paid to the pensioners alongwith with arrears from 01-07-2021 to 31-08-2021 alongwith the pension for the month of September, 2021.

Subject: Revised rates of Dearness Relief to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners w.e.f. 01-07-2021.

The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of Finance (Department of

Expenditure) Office Memorandum No. 1/1/2020-E-II(B), dated 23-04-2020, vide which instalments of Dearness Relief to pensioners/family pensioners due from 01-01-2020, 01-07-2020 and 01-01-2021, were frozen and to say that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Relief admissible to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 17% to 28% of the basic pension/family pension (including additional pension/family pension) with effect from 1st July, 2021. The increase subsumes the additional instalments arising on 01-01-2020, 01-07-2020 and 01-01-2021. The rate of Dearness Relief, earlier determined vide this Department's OM No. 42/04/2019-P&PW(D) dated 21-10-2019, shall remain at 17% of basic pension/family pension for the period from 01-01-2020 till 30-06-2021.

2. These rates of Dearness Relief will be applicable to:

i. Civilian Central Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners including Central Government absorbed pensioners in PSU/Autonomous Bodies in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's OM No. 4/34/2002-P&PW(D)Vol.II dated 23-06-2017 for restoration of full pension after expiry of commutation period of 15 years.

ii. The Armed Forces Pensioners/family pensioners and Civilian Pensioners/family pensioners paid out of the Defence Service Estimates.

iii. All India Service Pensioners/family pensioners.

iv. Railway Pensioners/family pensioners.

v. Pensioners who are in receipt of provisional pension.

vi. The Burma Civilian pensioners/family pensioners and displaced pensioners/

family pensioners from Pakistan, in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's O.M. No. 23/3/2008-P&PW(B) dated 11-09-2017.

3. The payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

4. Other provisions governing grant of Dearness Relief in respect of employed family pensioners and re-employed Central Government Pensioners will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in this Department's O.M. No. 45/73/97-P&PW(G) dated 2-7-1999 as amended from time to time. The provisions relating to regulation of Dearness Relief where a pensioner is in receipt of more than one pension will remain unchanged.

5. In the case of retired Judges of the Supreme Court and High Courts, necessary orders will be issued by the Department of Justice separately.

6. It will be the responsibility of the pension disbursing authorities, including the nationalized banks, etc. to calculate the quantum of Dearness Relief payable in each individual case.

7. The offices of Accountant General and authorised Pension Disbursing Banks are requested to arrange payment of Dearness Relief to pensioners/family pensioners on the basis of these instructions without waiting for any further instructions from the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Reserve Bank of India in view of letter No. 528-TA,II/34-80-II dated 23-04-1981 of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India addressed to all Accountant Generals and Reserve Bank of India Circular No. GANB No. 2958/GA-64 (ii) (CGL)/81 dated the 21st May, 1981 addressed to State Bank of India and its subsidiaries and all Nationalised Banks.

8. In their application to the persons belonging to Indian Audit and Accounts

Department, these orders are issued under Article 148(5) of the Constitution and after consultation with the Comptroller & Auditor General of India.

9. This issues in pursuance of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure's O.M. No. 1/1/2020-E.II(B) dated 20th July, 2021.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the existing recruitment rules for the relevant posts specified herein below, the Governor of Goa hereby makes the following rules to regulate the recruitment to the Goa General Service, Group 'B', Gazetted, Non-Ministerial posts, in the Directorate of Women and Child Development, Government of Goa, namely:—

1. *Short title, application and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Goa, Directorate of Women and Child Development, Group 'B', Gazetted, Non-Ministerial posts, Recruitment Rules, 2021.

(2) They shall apply to the posts specified in column (2) of the Schedule to these rules (hereinafter called as the "said Schedule").

(3) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Number, classification and level in the Pay Matrix.*— The number of posts, classification of the said posts and level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (3) to (5) of the said Schedule.

Provided that the Government may vary the number of posts as specified in column (3) of the said Schedule from time to time subject to exigencies of work.

3. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.*— The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (6) to (14) of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualification.*— No person who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or who, having

a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the service:

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where, the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Goa Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in that regard.

These rules are issued in supersession of the existing Recruitment Rules for relevant posts, published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 2 dated 11-04-1986 vide Government Notification No. 1/10/78-PER (Vol. II) dated 11-02-1986; and published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 23 dated 04-09-1986 vide Government Notification No. 1/10/78-PER dated 13-08-1986.

These rules are issued in consultation with the Goa Public Service Commission conveyed vide their letter No. COM/II/13/66 (1)/2021/511 dated 26-07-2021 and No. COM/II/13/66 (2)/2021/138 dated 23-07-2021.
