2. NBCC (India) Ltd. shall be responsible to maintain the assets, services of the BUA retained by Government of Goa including Social Infrastructure as well as special repairs for a period of 20 (5+15)

years. The expenditure of for special repairs, a lump sum provision will be made as determined by Finance Management Committee.

3. The Finance Management Committee shall fix for annual general maintenance & special repair of retained BUA by Government of Goa, on submission of a detailed proposal by NBCC (India) Ltd. Finance Management Committee should be approached only in case of additional works beyond the amount approved for annual general maintenance.
4. NBCC (India) Ltd. shall open and maintain separate Books of Accounts for each project. NBCC (India) Ltd. shall submit quarterly returns of the physical and financial progress of the project to Government of Goa in the format prescribed by the Finance Management Committee.
5. The Finance Management Committee shall review the status of Escrow Account on yearly basis, and determine the amount, accrued in excess of 20% above the total cost approved by the Government of Goa for redevelopment of all the above seven projects, to be deposited to Government of Goa.

The Terms of Reference of the DOS-CMG is as under:

- i. The DOS-CMG will be the apex body in the district to deal with major oil pollution incidents and to provide expert guidance for handling oil pollution incidents.
- ii. The DOS-CMG shall meet at least once in six months and send a report to the State Oil Spill Crisis Management Group (SOSCMG) within 5 working days after completion of the said meeting.
- iii. Identify eco-sensitive areas in their respective jurisdiction.
- iv. Identify specific resource requirements if any.
- v. The DOS-CMG may:-
 - a. Review all the facility-level oil spill contingency plans prepared by the occupier of Major Accident Hazards installation viz., sea ports and oil installations for the preparation of the district oil spill contingency plan;
 - b. Assist in the preparation of the district oil spill contingency procedure in line with the GOA-SOS-DCP;
 - c. Assist the district administration in the management of oil pollution incidents;
 - d. Continuously monitor every oil pollution incident and maintain log records of the same;
 - e. Ensure continuous information flow from the district to the National Oil Spill Crisis Management Group (NOS-CMG) and State Oil Spill Crisis Management Group (SOSCMG) regarding oil pollution incident situation and mitigation efforts;

- f. Forward a final case report as defined in GOA-SOS-DCP-01 of the oil pollution incident within fifteen days to the SOSCMG; on closure of emergency and
- g. Conduct atleast one full-scale mockdrill of differing scenarios of an oil pollution incident at a facility, each year and forward a report of the strength and the weaknesses of the plan to the SOS-CMG within 5 days of completion.
- h. Invite wider participation to ensure that all interests are duly represented and that their resources and services are considered.
- i. Concerned Authority shall provide contact details of a link Officer for the nominated representatives with contact details 24 x 7, in case of authorized non-availability.

1. The LOS-CMG is the body at the local level to deal with oil pollution incidents and co-ordinate efforts in planning, preparedness and mitigation of an oil pollution incident.
2. The LOS-CMG shall meet every quarter and forward a copy of the proceedings to the District Oil Spill Crisis Management Group (DOSCMG) within 5 working days after the completion of the said meeting.
3. The LOS-CMG may:-
 - a. Identify eco-sensitive areas in their respective jurisdiction;
 - b. Identify specific resource requirements if any;
 - c. Prepare a local oil spill contingency procedure in line with the GOA-SOS-DCP;
 - d. Ensure dovetailing of the local oil spill contingency procedure with the district oil spill contingency procedure;
 - e. Train personnel involved in oil pollution incident management;
 - f. Educate the population likely to be affected in an oil pollution incident about the remedies and existing preparedness in the area;
 - g. Conduct at least one full-scale mock drill of differing scenarios of an oil pollution incident at a site every six months and submit a report to the DOS-CMG within 5 days of completion;
 - h. Respond to all public inquiries on the subject within 5 days of receipt; and

- i. Invite wider participation to ensure that all interests are represented and that their resources and services are considered.
- j. Concerned Authority shall provide contact details of a link Officer for the nominated representatives with contact details 24 x 7, in case of authorized non-availability.
