Saving.— Nothing in these regulations shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Exservicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in that regard.
- 9. These Regulations are made in supersession of existing Rules namely Info Tech Corporation of Goa Limited (ITG) Post Recruitment Rules.
