In pursuance to Section 135B of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (Act 43 of 1951), the Government of Goa hereby declares Thursday, the 9th April, 2026 (Chaitra 19, Saka 1948) as a “Paid Holiday” being the “Polling Day” for the General Elections to Kerala Legislative Assembly and Puducherry Legislative Assembly, 2026 to every person employed in any business, trade, industrial undertaking or any other establishment and entitled to vote at the aforesaid General Election, throughout the State of Goa.

The aforesaid holiday shall be a “paid holiday”, in addition to the holidays indicated in the Notification No. 37/3/2025-GAD-III/4171 dated 30-09-2025 published in the Official Gazette, Series II No. 28 dated 09-10-2025 read with Corrigendum No. 37/8/2025-GAD-III/4282 dated 07-10-2025 and shall also be applicable as such to the following persons who are entitled to vote at the aforesaid General Election:-

- (i) workers of all establishments including commercial and industrial undertakings in the State of Goa;
- (ii) daily wage/casual workers employed in any business, trade, industrial undertakings, Government departments, State Government Industrial Departments or any other establishment.
