The following draft rules which the Government of Goa proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 77 read with Clause (a) of sub-section (2) of Section 85 of the Indian Ports Act, 2025 (Central Act No. 27 of 2025) so as to further amend the Goa Ports Rules, 1983, are hereby pre-published as

required by sub-section (1) of Section 77 of the said Act for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said rules will be taken into consideration by the Government after expiry of a period of 15 days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.

All objections and/or suggestions to the said draft Rules may be forwarded to the Captain of Ports and ex officio Joint Secretary to the Government of Goa, Captain of Ports Department, Panaji, before the expiry of the said period of fifteen days so that they may be taken into consideration at the time of finalization of the said draft Rules.

### DRAFT RULES

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 77 read with Clause (a) of sub-section (2) of Section 85 of the Indian Ports Act, 2025 (Central Act No. 27 of 2025) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to further amend the Goa Ports Rules, 1983, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Ports (Amendment) Rules, 2026.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their final publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Amendment of Rule 54A.*— In Rule 54A of the Goa Ports Rules, 1983 in the Schedule, the existing entries against serial number (5) shall be omitted.

3. *Amendment of Schedule-I.*— In Schedule-I appended to the principal Rules for item No. “20. MOORING” and entries thereunder, the following item shall be substituted, namely: -

“20. Installation of Fishing Cage/Rack/Stakes for traditional fishermen in river.

Fees of Rs. 5,000/- for permission to install Fishing Cage/Rack/Stakes for traditional fishermen in rivers shall be charged. The validity of such permission shall be of three years subject to annual verification by the Department”.

b. The beneficiary shall either produce the bills from the registered dealers towards the purchase of above mentioned accessories or the beneficiary can procure the accessories from the Department.

c. The applicant shall obtain the prescribed application form issued by Directorate of Fisheries from B.D.O. office/sub-offices of Directorate of Fisheries and submit the duly filled application form to concern fisheries official posted at B.D.O. office/sub-office of Directorate of Fisheries.

*Sr. 5 Sub Point (a & b).*

*Pattern of Assistance:* a. The beneficiary belonging to General/SC/ST/Women Category is eligible for the grant of 90% subsidy limited to Rs. 9,000/- on a unit cost of Rs. 10,000/-.

The Government of Goa vide Notification No. 11/13/91-HD(G) dated 20/08/2013, published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 22 dated 29/08/2013 (hereinafter called the “Principal Notification”) framed the Scheme for providing employment in Government to the children of Freedom Fighters as announced in the Budget Speech 2013-14. The Government desired that the continuity of the said Scheme is essential to bestow the benefits under the said Scheme to the children of Freedom Fighters registered with the Home Department, the Government of Goa is pleased to amend the said Scheme as under:

### **Amendment of Clause 3**

Clause 3 (c) of the said Scheme shall be read as under:

“(c) However, the prevalent reservation of 2% points under Group ‘A’ and ‘B’ based on roster points shall continue vis-a-vis posts filled through GPSC w.e.f. 01/03/2026 to 28/02/2027”.

### **Amendment of Clause 7**

Clause 7 of the Scheme shall be read as under:

“The Scheme shall be valid for further period w.e.f. 01/03/2026 to 28/02/2027” or till the last candidate of 79 registered children of Freedom Fighters in the Home Department get sponsored for the employment”.

This issues with the approval of the Council of Minister in the One Hundred and Fifth (CVth) Cabinet Meeting held on 17/06/2026 under the Chairmanship of the Chief Minister.

Whereas, the Government of Goa has notified The Goa Freedom Fighters Welfare Rules, 2013 vide Notification 11-14-96-HD(G)/4021 dated 05/12/2013 to bestow certain benefits to the Freedom Fighters of Goa registered in the Home Department (General), Secretariat, Porvorim-Goa and further vide Notification No. 11/463/90-HD(G)/629 dated 23/02/2023 amended to enhance the financial benefits.

Now, the Government of Goa hereby amend these rules to enhance the Financial Assistance:

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These Rules may be called “The Goa Freedom Fighters Welfare (Amendment) Rules, 2026”.

(2) These shall come into force with effect from 01/04/2026.

2. *Amendment to Rule 4.*— In Rule 4 of the Goa Freedom Fighters Welfare (Amendment) Rules, 2022, for the expression “Rs. 9000/- plus applicable Dearness Allowances as per the rate announced by Central Government from time to time”, the expression “Rs. 12000/- plus applicable Dearness Allowance as per the Order No. 8/1/2016-Fin(R&C)/(A) dated 30/11/2016 under 7th Pay Commission” shall be substituted.

3. *Amendment to Rule 5.*— In Rule 5 of the Goa Freedom Fighters Welfare (Amendment) Rules, 2022, for the word and figure “Rs. 3000/-”, the word and figure “Rs. 5000/-” shall be substituted.

The enhanced benefits to the above Rules shall be effective from 01/04/2026.

Government of Goa is pleased to notify scheme “Mukhya Mantri Janjatiya Mhaje Ghar Yojana” - Financial Assistance to purchase or regularize Dwelling House with Land for the people from Scheduled Tribe Community in the State of Goa in public interest and the Scheme shall come into force from the date of publication of notification in the Official Gazette.

1. *Introduction.*— The Government of Goa has launched “Mhaje Ghar Yojana” on 04th October, 2025 by making necessary amendments in the Acts, i.e. The Goa Legislative Diploma No. 2070 dated 15-4-1961, The Goa Land Revenue Code Act, The Goa Regularization of Unauthorized Construction Act, etc. with the aim of regularizing houses built on Government land, Private land and Comunidade land giving legal rights to residents.

Though the fee structure fixed under the Mhaje Ghar scheme is at the nominal rates, however, still most of the population belonging to the Scheduled Tribe community may find it difficult to pay these fees.

Therefore, in order to give financial support to such Tribal population, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Goa has announced the new scheme "Mukhya Mantri Janjatiya Mhaje Ghar Yojana" in the Budget Speech 2026-27 and accordingly the present scheme has been framed and shall be implemented to achieve its objectives as under;

2. *Short title of the scheme.*— This scheme shall be called as "Mukhya Mantri Janjatiya Mhaje Ghar Yojana"—Financial Assistance to purchase or regularize Dwelling House/Land for the people from Scheduled Tribe Community of State of Goa.

3. *Objective.*— To provide financial assistance to the eligible person belonging to the Scheduled Tribe Community of Goa to enable them to exercise their right to purchase or regularize the dwelling house with land at the price determined by the Competent Authority.

4. *Eligibility.*— (a) Person shall belong to the Scheduled Tribe Community in the State of Goa.

(b) The family income from all sources should not exceed Rs. 5.00 lakhs per annum.

(c) Persons shall have availed the benefit of the Mhaje Ghar Scheme under the following Acts;

1. Under Section 372-B of Goa Legislative Diploma No. 2070 dated 15-4-1961 (Amendment) Act, 2025 or

2. Under Section 38A of Goa Land Revenue Code (Amendment) Act, 2025 or

3. Under the 20-Point Programme Scheme in accordance with the provision of Section 21 of the Goa Land Revenue Code, 1968 (Circular No. 4/16/1/2023-RD-II/7414 dated 16/09/2025) or

4. Under Section 3 of Goa Regularization of Unauthorized Construction (Amendment) Act, 2025.

5. *Benefit under the scheme.*— (a) 100% Financial Assistance in form of reimbursement for Purchase or Regularisation of House with land of Pre-1972 with maximum limit of Rs. 1.00 lakh.

(b) 50% Financial Assistance in form of reimbursement for Purchase or Regularisation of House with land of Post-1972 with maximum limit of Rs. 1.00 lakh.

6. *Mode of Application.*— The application in the prescribed form to be submitted to the Directorate of Tribal Welfare, Panaji or to the O/o Dy. Director of Tribal Welfare supported with the following documents:

(i) Order from Competent Authority of Purchase/Regularization of house with land.

(ii) Challan Copy of payment.

(iii) House Tax receipt.

(iv) Photograph of the existing house along with the applicant.

(v) Income Certificate.

(vi) ST Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State of Goa.

(vii) Bank Pass Book Copy or Mandate form.

(viii) Copy of Ration card.

(ix) Copy of Aadhaar card.

7. *Sanctioning Authority.*— Director of Tribal Welfare shall sanction the amount of benefit under the scheme. Upon sanction of the benefit under the scheme, the amount shall be reimbursed to the applicant through direct benefit transfer.

8. *Monitoring of the scheme.*— Issues regarding eligibility or operation or of a new situation which is not envisaged at the time of formulation of the scheme, would be resolved by the Monitoring Committee, whose decision will be final.

The Monitoring Committee shall consist of:

- a) Secretary (Tribal Welfare), Chairperson
- b) Director (Tribal Welfare), Member
- c) Under Secretary (Revenue-I), Member

9. *Validity of the scheme.*— The scheme shall be implemented for two years. However, as per the need and necessity the scheme may be further extended by the Government.

10. *Relaxation of the provision of the scheme.*— The Government shall be empowered to relax any clauses or conditions of the scheme if a genuine requirement arises on case to case basis.

11. *Interpretation of the provision of the scheme.*— If any question arises regarding interpretation of any clause, word, expression of the scheme, the decision about the interpretation shall lie with the Government, and this decision shall be final and binding on all concerned.

12. *The expenditure shall be incurred under the following Budget Head.*—

- 2225 — Welfare of SCs, ST and Other Backward Classes;
  - 02 — Welfare of Scheduled Tribes;
  - 800 — Other Expenditure;
    - 06 — Mukhya Mantri Janjatiya Mhaje Ghar Yojana;
    - 00 — General;
    - 50 — Other Charges.

13. *Expenditure towards awareness of the Scheme.*— Every year 5% of the Budget allocated, shall be utilized towards the awareness and promotion of the scheme.

14. *Application Form.*— Application Form under the scheme “Mukhya Mantri Janjatiya Mhaje Ghar Yojana” is as per Annexure-A.

This is issued with administrative approval of the Government vide U.O. No. 32/F dated 08/05/2026 and concurrence of the Finance (Exp.) Department vide U. No. 1400126983 dated 16/06/2026.
