Whereas, in order to encourage and promote river tourism during the months of monsoon i.e. from June to 15th September, the Government has issued Notification No. B-14000/WS/Special Permission/COP published in Official Gazette, Extraordinary No. 3, Series I No. 14 dated 07th July, 2023, for granting permission to conduct watersports activities in inland waters of the State of Goa, during fair weather of the monsoon season, subject to the terms and conditions specified therein.

And whereas, as per the NOC issued under the said Notification, NOC of the Tourism Department is required to be obtained prior to operating the boat;

And whereas, it is noticed that there are no designated zones demarcated/notified by the Department of Tourism as watersports activity zone for Monsoon as per the above notification.

Whereas, the Government has notified a scheme “Chief Minister’s—Coding And Robotics Education in Schools Scheme” and referred to as CM-CARES Scheme vide Notification No. DTE/BUD 21/CM-CARES/2021/264 notified in Official Gazette, Series I No. 7 dated 13th May, 2021.

And whereas, the Government amended “Chief Minister’s—Coding And Robotics Education in Schools Scheme” vide notification No. DTE/BUD 21/CM-CARES/2021/4036 notified in Official Gazette, Series I No. 53 dated 31/03/2022.

And whereas, the Government desires to further amend the Scheme “Chief Minister’s—Coding And Robotics Education in Schools Scheme”.

Now therefore, the Scheme “Chief Minister’s–Coding And Robotics Education in Schools Scheme” is further modified/amended to be read as under:—

1) In Clause 3-Abbreviations & Definitions of the “Chief Minister’s–Coding And Robotics Education in Schools Scheme”, the following would need to be appended to “MT Mathematical Thinking”.

2) In Clause 5 Mission, at 5.1 (b) of the “Chief Minister’s–Coding And Robotics Education in Schools Scheme” to be read as “Incrementally develop required resources (hardware/software/technical) in Government/Government-Aided schools by focusing at Foundational Stage, Preparatory Stage, Middle Stage and at the Secondary Stage as per National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 for schools and then extending to other standards as the need be.”

3) Clause 5.1 (f) of the “Chief Minister’s–Coding And Robotics Education in Schools Scheme” to be read as “Developing appropriate curriculum for CT/DT/MT”.

4) Clause 21: Duration of the scheme, 21.1 of the “Chief Minister’s–Coding And Robotics Education in Schools Scheme”, the following would need to be read as “The scheme will be valid for a period of 3 years from the date of notification in the Official Gazette”.

5) In Clause 13.1, j of the “Chief Minister’s–Coding And Robotics Education in Schools Scheme”, the following would need to be read as “The staff required could be taken on deputation, with applicable deputation allowance as per rules; from the various GoG Departments or Government aided institutes, and/or on contract basis as decided by the Empowered Committee for a tenure of up to 5 years to drive the initiative. Officers thus drawn appointed would be of the grade of Professor/Associate Professor, Assistant Professor/Head, Masters/Teacher Grade-I, higher or equivalent, as the case may be”.

The above modification/amendment to the scheme is with approval of the Government vide U.O. No. 1804/F dated 21/05/2026.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 13A, 13B (1), 13F (1) and 13F (3) of the Goa Public Gambling Act, 1976 (Act 14 of 1976) read with Section 21 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 (Central Act 10 of 1897), the Government of Goa hereby further amends the Government Notification No. 2-20-92-HD(G) dated 09-11-1995, published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 34 dated 23-11-1995 (hereinafter called the “principal Notification”), as follows, namely:—

(1) In the principal Notification,— in condition 1, for Clause (x), the following clause shall be substituted namely:—

“(x) Designated licensed places/areas means a separated area in a five-star hotel or vessel partitioned with access control where the licensee is authorized to install and operate electronic amusements/slot machines or table games”;

(2) in condition 5,—

(i) in Clause (vii), after sub-clauses (A) and (B), the following sub-clause (C) shall be inserted, namely:—

“(C) For any delayed payment of Annual Recurring Fee by the licensee, the licensee shall be liable to pay penal interest at the rate of 18% per annum on the outstanding amount”.

(ii) for Clause (xiii), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(xiii) No person below the age of twenty one years shall be allowed entry by the licensee at a designated licensed places/areas where a licensee installs and operates games of electronic amusements/slot machines or table games in a five star hotel or vessel”.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 15 of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 (Central Act 67 of 1957) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to further amend the Goa Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1985, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Minor Mineral Concession (Amendment) Rules, 2026.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Amendment of Rule 47.*— In Rule 47 of the Goa Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1985 (hereinafter referred to as the “principal Rules”):—

(i) in sub-rule (2), in the Table, after entry at serial No. (3), the following entry shall be inserted, namely:—

“(4)	For transportation of minor mineral by waterways, including by sea	Rupees 65/- per metric tonne.”
------	--	--------------------------------

(ii) after sub-rule (4), the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“(5) The despatch of minor minerals brought into the State of Goa to any other State or Union Territory in India shall require the payment of additional processing fee as may be notified by the Government.”

3. *Insertion of new Rule 47A.*— In the principal Rules, after Rule 47, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“47A. *Application to Competent Officer to bring minor mineral from outside Goa for export.*— (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in Rule 47, any person who intends to bring any minor mineral into the State of Goa from outside the State of Goa for export, shall apply to the Competent Officer for permission, stating the nature/type, quantity, origin, destination of the minor mineral and the mode of transport thereof.

(2) The applicant shall pay the processing fee of Rs. 65/- per metric tonne along with the application under sub-rule (1).

(3) The Competent Officer may, by Order, formulate a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for the purposes of regulating import of minor mineral for the purposes of export.

(4) The Competent Officer or an Officer authorized by the Competent Officer may, after considering the application and upon being satisfied that the applicant has followed the SOP at every stage of mineral transit and processing, issue necessary permit as specified in the SOP.”

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Goa hereby makes the following rules to regulate the recruitment to the Group ‘C’, Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial posts, in the Directorate of Art and Culture, Government of Goa, namely:-

1. *Short title, application and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Goa, Directorate of Art and Culture, Group ‘C’, Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial posts, Recruitment Rules, 2026.

(2) They shall apply to the posts specified in column (2) of the Schedule to these rules (hereinafter called as the “said Schedule”).

(3) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Number, classification and level in the pay matrix.*— The number of posts, classification of the said posts and level in the pay matrix attached thereof shall be as specified in columns (3) to (5) of the said Schedule:

Provided that the Government may vary the number of posts as specified in column (3) of the said Schedule from time to time subject to exigencies of work.

3. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.*— The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (6) to (14) of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualification.*— No person who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the service:

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where, the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in that regard.

Sub.: Issue of notification of a new scheme “Mukhyamantri Sukanya Kaushal Vikas Protsahan Yojana–2026” for granting 100% Tuition Fee Waiver to female candidates enrolling in Government Industrial Training Institutes (I.T.I.s) in the State of Goa.

1. *Introduction.*— The Directorate of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (DSDE) imparts vocational training in Engineering and Non-Engineering trades under National Council for Vocational Education and Training (NCVT) and State Council for Vocational Training (SCVT) to approximately 4000 trainees every year through the ten Government Industrial Training Institutes (I.T.I.s) and three Private Industrial Training Institutes (I.T.I.s) spread across the State of Goa. The Directorate has an existing provision for reservation of seats in the Government I.T.I.s for admissions to various categories of candidates including 30% reservation for female candidates. However, only 550-600 i.e. about 19-20% of female candidates on an average are found to be taking admission in Government I.T.I.s every year.

The low participation of females/women in skill training and technical education has always remained a challenge for the Department. The probable reasons drawn from various sources for the low participation are a female candidate may be willing to learn various skills at the I.T.I.s and get employed or self-employed, however the financial constraints faced by her family prevent her from joining the I.T.I.s; with no additional attractive incentive or benefit offered to the female candidates, the candidate herself and/or her family members do not want to send their girl child to learn skills in the I.T.I.; a female candidate and/or her parents have a typical mind-set that hard core trades/skills are meant only for males, and females have to opt for soft trades or be at home doing the daily chores as it will be helpful to her after marriage.

In order to change such mind-set, reduce financial burden on the female candidates and on their parents, and encourage female participation in skill training in the I.T.I.s so as to make them employable and self-reliant, it is proposed to provide 100% Tuition Fee Waiver to female candidates taking admission in the Government I.T.I.s in Goa, through a new scheme thereby promoting women empowerment, better employability and self-reliance.

2. *Short title and commencement.*— i) This scheme shall be called as the Mukhyamantri Sukanya Kaushal Vikas Protsahan Yojana (MSKVPPY)–2026 scheme for granting 100% tuition fee waiver to female trainees getting admitted in the Government I.T.I.s in Goa.

ii) This scheme shall come into force from commencement of admissions to I.T.I.s from the academic year 2026-27 onwards.

iii) This scheme will be implemented by the Directorate of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (DSDE).

3. *Scope and Objectives.*— i) To promote skill development among female candidates by providing them with free access to quality vocational and technical training.

ii) To encourage higher participation of females/women belonging to all social categories in skill development programmes conducted in Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in the State of Goa.

iii) To reduce financial barriers that hinder females from enrolling in and completing skill training programmes.

iv) To enhance female enrolment in I.T.I.s, especially in hard core trades and reduce dropout rates.

v) To enhance employability, entrepreneurship, and self-reliance among females through certified skill training.

vi) To create a skilled, confident and industry-ready women workforce aligned with present and future market requirements.

4. *Eligibility for providing Fee Waiver.*— i) The candidate/beneficiary seeking admission in any of the 6 months, 1 year or 2 years duration NCVET or SCVT affiliated courses/trades conducted under the Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) of Directorate General of Training at the Government ITIs should be a female.

ii) The candidate/beneficiary should have been born in Goa or a resident of Goa for the last 10 years from the date of applying for admission in Government I.T.I. in Goa.

iii) The candidate/beneficiary should fulfil educational qualification criteria applicable to the particular trade/course she desires to take admission.

5. *Implementing Authority.*— The scheme will be implemented and managed by Directorate of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship through the Government Industrial Training Institutes in Goa.

6. *Details of Fee Waiver.*— The amount on which 100% fee waiver is granted to the eligible candidate/beneficiary shall consist of the Tuition Fee as decided and approved by the Government of Goa for a particular Academic year/Training session.

7. *Monitoring and Control.*— The female candidate should upload her details and supporting documentary evidence on the online admission portal. The concerned Government I.T.I authorities should verify the details/documents thoroughly and ensure that they are available on the portal for a specific period as decided by the Department and also in the I.T.I. records.

8. *Validity and Evaluation of the Scheme.*— Performance of the Scheme shall be evaluated after three years of its notification in the Official Gazette i.e. in the year 2028-29 and if required the scheme will be suitably modified to meet the new changes/requirements so as to achieve the objective.

9. *Publicity and social media.*— The Directorate will announce the scheme through Hon'ble Chief Minister's Budget Speech for F.Y. 2026-27, I.T.I. Prospectus and later through social media/FM Radio.
