Whereas, the Additional Inspector General of Prisons vide letter No. 29/1493/2026/IGP/618 dated 17/03/2026 has requested to urgently declare a Central Jail Colvale as “NO DRONE FLY ZONE” to safeguard institutional Security, maintain Prison Discipline and uphold the integrity of the Criminal Justice System.

And whereas, considering the necessity to maintain vigilance and to stop and restrain the unauthorized movement/flying of drones within the restricted area of Central Jail Colvale, the recommendation of the Additional IG Prisons with the approval of the Competent Authorities was forwarded to the District

Magistrate, North Goa, Panaji-Goa with a request to declare a designated area around the Central Jail premises as “NO DRONE ZONE OR NO FLY ZONE”.

And whereas, the District Magistrate, North Goa, Panaji-Goa vide Order No. 8/8/2023-MAG/L&O(Vol.II)/1605 dated 08/05/2026 has issued an Order under Section 163 of BNSS declaring the Central Jail, Colvale and its surrounding premises as a “No Drone Fly Zone” for a period of 60 days.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 69 of the Information Technology Act, 2000 (Act 21 of 2000) read with Rule 3 and Rule 4 of the Information Technology (Procedure and Safeguards for Interception, Monitoring and Decryption of information) Rules, 2009, undersigned being the Competent authority under the said Rules, hereby authorizes the Inspector General of Police, Goa Police Department, for the purposes of Interception, monitoring and decryption of any information generated, transmitted, received or stored in any computer resource under the said Act, in case of emergencies only.

And whereas, suggestions received from public were placed before the Goa Town and Country Planning Board in terms of sub-rule (3) of Rule 4 for its recommendation/approval and the Goa Town and Country Planning Board after due consideration of the suggestions received from the public recommended the proposals for change of zone as regards to Sr. No. 1 in its 217th Meeting held on 29-07-2025, Sr. No. 2, 3 & 10 in its 231st Meeting held on 21-04-2026, Sr. No. 4 & 7 in its 235th Meeting held on 10-06-2026, Sr. No. 5 & 6 in its 233rd Meeting held on 18-05-2026, Sr. No. 8 & 9 in its 236th Meeting held on 29-06-2026, and directed to take further action as per sub-rule (4) of Rule 4 of the said Rules;

And whereas, as required by sub-rule (4) of Rule 4 of the said Rules, the recommendation/approval/decision of the Goa Town and Country Planning Board along with the said proposals were placed before the Government for its decision and the Government has approved the same;

Now, therefore, in view of the recommendation of the Goa Town and Country Planning Board being approved by the Government and in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 39A of the Goa Town and Country Planning Act, 1974 (Act 21 of 1975) read with sub-rule (5) of Rule 4 of the Goa Town and Country Planning (Change of zone of land in the Regional Plan or the Outline Development Plan) Rules, 2024, the Regional Plan is hereby altered and modified as specified in Column No. (8) of above Table and as directed by the Government for carrying out change of zone of land in respect of the plots of land as specified in detail in Column Nos. (2) to (7) of above Table.

The alteration and modification of the Regional Plan as notified in this Notification shall be subject to the outcome of the PIL Writ Petition Nos. 53 of 2024 and 54 of 2024 which are pending final disposal before the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay at Goa.
