2. The Nominee shall refrain himself from representing before any other Registrar's Nominee/Board of Nominee as a legal practitioner of a party to the dispute under the provisions of the Goa Co-operative Societies Act, 2001 and Rules, 2003;
3. Arbitration fee shall be charged as provided under the Goa Co-operative Societies Act, 2001 and Rules, 2003;

4. The application regarding reference of dispute shall be accompanied with documentary proof towards payment of fees payable to the Government by way of e-challan and e-receipt as prescribed under the Goa Co-operative Societies Rules, 2003 without which proceedings should not be commenced;
5. This order shall remain in force for one year unless extended and its issue can also be withdrawn at anytime without assigning any reasons by the undersigned. Henceforth extension of term of its dedicated Registrar's Nominee, then such proposal shall be submitted to the office of the Asstt. Read: Notification No. 8/6/2026-LA/159 dated 06-07-2026 of Department of Law, Government of Goa, Secretariat, Porvorim-Goa.

Whereas, the Goa Co-operative Societies (Amendment) Ordinance, 2026 (Ordinance No. 6 of 2026) has been promulgated by the Hon'ble Governor of Goa on 06/07/2026. Accordingly, the Department of Law, Legal Affairs Division has notified and published the aforesaid ordinance in the Official Gazette (Extraordinary), Series I No. 14 dated 06/07/2026 for information of general public.

And whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 113A of the Goa Co-operative Societies Act, 2001, the Department of Co-operation had constituted a panel of Reconciliators for hearing disputes or differences of opinion amongst members and for addressing instances of non-compliance or delay in compliance affecting the members of the co-operative society.

And whereas, the Goa Co-operative Societies (Amendment) Ordinance, 2026 has introduced a separate statutory authority known as SAHARA i.e. Society's Advisory, Harmony and Redressal Authority and consequently the provisions of Section 113A of the Goa Co-operative Societies Act, 2001 have become redundant.

And whereas, the SAHARA Authority is yet to be constituted and in the intervening period an administrative vacuum would arise in relation to the receipt, hearing and disposal of matters previously dealt with by the Reconciliators. It is therefore considered necessary in the interest of ensuring continuity of the dispute resolution mechanism and avoiding hardship to members and co-operative societies to provide for an interim arrangement untill the SAHARA Authority is duly constituted.

Now therefore, pending the constitution of the SAHARA Authority, the Government in exercise of powers conferred under Section 68 of the Goa Co-operative Societies Act, 2001 (Goa Act 36 of 2001) hereby order that the existing panel of Reconciliators appointed under erstwhile Section 113A of the Goa Co-operative Societies Act, 2001 shall continue to receive, entertain, hear and decide matters and exercise the powers and discharge the functions entrusted to them immediately before the commencement of the Goa Co-operative Societies (Amendment) Ordinance, 2026, until the SAHARA Authority is duly constituted or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

The VDA shall be payable w.e.f. 1st October, 2025 based on the AAICPI points April to June, 2025 beyond base 9250 points AAICPI (1960=100).

- (b) What is meant by dedicated “maintenance”? At present the electric buses suffer frequent break-downs. These break-downs concern the steering wheel (especially due to non-replacement of the ‘Steering-cross’), severe vibrations of the vehicles, (Suspensions of the vehicles are damaged), non-functioning of A/C, Worn-out/Tyres of the vehicles: Especially the front tyres are bald and the tyres fitted to the vehicle are invariably re-moulded, suspension bushes are not replaced once worn-out, No proper Wheel-alignment done and checked leaking bus-roofs, all these above state of the electric buses inconveniencing to the travelling public who otherwise gain comfort and prefer EV buses.
- (c) Threats to Electric Bus Drivers who report on vehicle disorders: the electric drivers who call out and report any deficiencies in the maintenance of electric buses are singled-out, harassed, humiliated, threatened and victimised. Such an attitude by the administrators of EV buses under KTCL does not serve the objective of offering safe, prompt, comfortable, luxurious, environment-friendly, yet affordable travel to the people in the State of Goa as well as Tourists who travel on EV buses.
