In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 129 read with Sections 13 and 15 of the Goa Housing Board Act, 1968 (Goa Act 12 of 1968), and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Goa Housing Board, with prior approval of Government of Goa, hereby makes the following regulations so as to further amend the Goa Housing Board Cadre, Recruitment of Staff, Functions, Powers and Sphere of Duties of Officers and other Employees Regulations, 2021, except as respect of things done or omitted to be done before such amendment, as follows, namely:-

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These regulations may be called the Goa Housing Board Cadre, Recruitment of Staff, Functions, Powers and Sphere of Duties of Officers and other Employees (First Amendment) Regulations, 2026.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Substitution of SCHEDULE -I.*— For SCHEDULE-I appended to the Goa Housing Board Cadre, Recruitment of Staff, Functions, Powers and Sphere of Duties of Officers and other Employees Regulations, 2021 (hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”) the following Schedule shall be substituted, namely:—

Whereas, the Goa Investment Promotion and Facilitation Board (hereinafter referred to as “the Board”) received an application dated 27/02/2025 from M/s. Venture Building Dreams Private Limited to construct a Cricket Academy and Allied Sports Arena in the areas as specified in the Schedules hereto (hereinafter referred to as the “said area”) which is on leased land (hereinafter referred to as the “said Project”);

And whereas, the Board granted in-principle approval for the said Project and recommended to the Government to declare the said area to be an Investment Promotion Area;

And whereas, the Government accepted the said recommendation of the Board and vide Proclamation No. 3/20/2025-IND/007 dated 06/01/2026, published in the Official Gazette, Series II No. 41 dated 08/01/2026 and in local newspaper viz “Bhaangarbhuin” and “The Goan Everyday” dated 07/01/2026 (hereinafter referred to as the “said Proclamation”) the Government proposed to,—

(a) declare the said area to be an Investment Promotion Area in terms of Clause (a) of sub-section (1) of Section 42 of the Goa Investment Promotion and Facilitation of Single Window Clearance Act, 2021 (Goa Act 19 of 2021) (hereinafter referred to as the “said Act”);

(b) appoint the Chief Executive Officer, Goa Investment Promotion and Facilitation Board, for the purpose of the assessment and recovery of house tax, other taxes, fees and all other types of dues as per the provisions of law in force, in terms of Clause (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 42 of the said Act;

(c) declare that the provisions of any State law relating to local authorities providing for control or erection of buildings, levy and collection of taxes, fees and other dues to the local authority which is in force in the said area shall cease to apply and thereupon such provisions shall cease to apply thereof and that the Municipal Corporation or the Municipality or the Village Panchayat which were receiving house tax, other taxes or fees from the occupants in the said area under their respective laws, shall be compensated by the Government to the extent of the last financial year’s collection of such house tax, other taxes or fees for a period of five years in terms of Clause (c) of sub-section (1) of Section 42 of the said Act;

(d) authorize the Chief Executive Officer of the Board for the purpose of exercising all the powers, such as, levy and collection of taxes, fees and other dues in respect of local authorities which are in force in the said area, in terms of Clauses (b) and (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 42 of the said Act. House tax, other taxes, fees and all other types of dues so collected by the Chief Executive Officer of the Board in respect of the said area, shall be deposited with the Government immediately by the Chief Executive Officer of the Board after such collection under Budget Head:—

0851 — Village and Small Industries;

00 — ---;

101 — Industrial Estates;

03-00 — Goa Investment Promotion Board – Conversion Sanad Fees;

04-00 — Goa Investment Promotion Board – Infrastructure Tax;

05-00 — Goa Investment Promotion Board – House Tax; and

(e) authorize the Planning, Development and Construction Committee appointed under sub-section (1) of Section 43 of the said Act, for exercising all the powers, such as control or erection of building, etc.

(hereinafter collectively called the “said proposal”) and invited all persons who entertain any objections to the said proposal to submit the same in writing with reasons therefor to the Director of

Industries, Trade and Commerce, Government of Goa, Panaji, Goa, within a period of one month from the date of publication of said Proclamation in the Official Gazette;

And whereas, the said Official Gazette was made available to the public on 08/01/2026;

And whereas, objections received in this regard have been considered by the Government under sub-section (3) of Section 42 of the said Act and the Government is of the opinion that the said objections are insufficient and invalid.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 42 of the Goa Investment Promotion and Facilitation of Single Window Clearance Act, 2021 (Goa Act 19 of 2021), the Government of Goa hereby,—

(a) declares whole of the said area as specified in the Schedules hereto to be an Investment Promotion Area;

(b) appoints the Chief Executive Officer of the Board for the purpose of the assessment and recovery of house tax, other taxes, fees and all other types of dues imposed as per the provisions of law in force;

(c) declares that the provisions of any State law relating to local authorities providing for control or erection of buildings, levy and collection of taxes, fees and other dues to the local authority which is in force in the said area shall cease to apply and that the Municipal Corporation or the Municipal Council or the Village Panchayat which were receiving house tax, other taxes or fees from the occupants in the said area under their respective laws, shall be compensated by the Government to the extent of the last financial year's collection of such house tax, other taxes or fees for a period of five years;

(d) authorizes the Chief Executive Officer of the Board for the purpose of exercising all the powers, such as levy and collection of taxes, fees and other dues in respect of local authorities which are in force in the said area. House tax, other taxes, fees and all other types of dues so collected in respect of said area, shall be deposited with the Government immediately by the Chief Executive Officer of the Board after such collection under the Budget Head:—

0851 — Village and Small Industries;

03-00 — Goa Investment Promotion Board – Conversion Sanad Fees;

04-00 — Goa Investment Promotion Board – Infrastructure Tax;

05-00 — Goa Investment Promotion Board – House Tax; and

(e) authorizes the Planning, Development and Construction Committee appointed under sub-section (1) of Section 43 of the said Act, for exercising all the powers, such as control or erection of building, etc. in the said area.

Mahila Digital Sashaktikaran Yojana Scheme

1. *Short title and commencement.*— a. This scheme is called “Mahila Digital Sashaktikaran Yojana”.

b. The scheme shall come into force from the date of the notification of its publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Introduction.*— a. Women play a vital role in every field, it is therefore ideal that we work towards empowerment of women from all walks of life, especially women in economically weaker sections and rural areas. Empowering women is crucial for fostering inclusive economic growth and social development. Despite progress in gender equality, women often face significant barriers to accessing education, employment, and economic opportunities. Bridging the digital divide through targeted training programs can be a powerful tool for empowering women by enhancing their skills, confidence, and socioeconomic prospects.

b. The Department of Information Technology, Electronics and Communications (DITE&C) constantly labors in promoting digital awareness among all sections of the society and empowering citizens by enhancing their Digital skills. As a step towards empowerment of women from all walks of life, achieving maximum outreach amongst the women, especially in rural areas and encouraging women towards enhancing their Digital skills, this Department has formulated the scheme namely “Mahila Digital Sashaktikaran Yojana”.

3. *Objective of the Scheme.*— a. The following are the objectives of the scheme:

- i. Encouraging women in enhancing their Digital skills.
- ii. Assist women to effectively use digital devices, navigate online platforms and equip women with the essential digital skills.
- iii. To enhance their employability and income-generating opportunities.
- iv. To promote women’s participation in the digital economy.

4. *Scope of the Scheme.*— a. Women who have completed 18 years of age can avail the benefit of the scheme.

b. Women residing in the State of Goa for atleast 15 years will be eligible to avail the benefits of the scheme. However, in absence of the 15 years Residence Certificate, submission of Voters ID Card is permitted as an alternative proof of residence.

c. This scheme can be availed through the empanelled IT Knowledge Centres (ITKCs), Citizens Service Centres (CSCs) under the Department of Information Technology Electronics and Communications, CSC-VLES registered by M/s Info Tech Corporation of Goa Ltd. (M/s ITG) for implementation of this scheme.

d. This scheme will be valid for a period of 3 years from date of notification and may be extended further based on performance of the scheme.

5. *Eligibility under the scheme.*— a. Women who have completed 18 years of age can avail the benefit of the scheme.

b. Women residing in the State of Goa for atleast 15 years will be eligible to avail the benefits of the scheme.

c. This scheme can be availed through the empanelled IT Knowledge Centres (ITKCs), Citizens Service Centres (CSCs) under the Department of Information Technology Electronics and Communications, CSC-VLES registered by M/s Info Tech Corporation of Goa Ltd. (M/s ITG) for implementation of this scheme.

6. *Procedure for applying.*— a. Applicant must be submit an Application online mode through Empanelled IT Knowledge Centres (ITKCs), Citizens Service Centres (CSCs) under the Department of Information Technology, Electronics and Communications (DITEC) or CSC-VLEs (Village Level Entrepreneurs) registered with M/s ITG through which the applicant would like to avail the courses which is developed.

b. Applicants must upload the following documents while applying:

- i. A copy of the duly filled application form.
- ii. One passport-size photograph with the applicant's signature on it.
- iii. An attested copy of the highest educational qualification certificate (if any).
- iv. A 15-year Residence Certificate.
- v. A copy of Aadhaar Card.

7. *Quantum of Financial Assistance under the Scheme.*— a. M/s Info Tech Corporation of Goa Ltd. (M/s ITG) is nominated as the implementing agency for the scheme.

b. Rs. 500 per person will be allocated for conducting the training/awareness program, which will cover; the ITKC, CSC or CSC-VLE (80%) and ITG (20%) charges. However, considering that the CSCs and CSC-VLEs may have space constraints in their existing setup and to encourage these CSCs and CSC-VLEs to conduct the training/awareness program in locations more accessible and convenient for the women beneficiaries, such as Panchayat halls, School halls, halls of any religious buildings, etc., an additional amount of Rs. 100 per person will be allocated as infrastructure cost only to the CSCs and CSC-VLEs.

c. The Department of Information Technology, Electronics and Communications shall reimburse M/s ITG against the invoices raised, based on the number of women who have successfully completed the course and infrastructure cost if any.

8. *Pattern of Assistance.*— a. The grants shall be utilized exclusively for Mahila Digital Sashaktikaran Yojana.

b. The entire amount of the grants should be utilized within a period of one financial year and only for the purpose for which it is sanctioned. Any portion of the grant, which is not ultimately required, will be refunded to the Government. After utilizing/refunding the sanctioned amount, Utilization Certificate should be furnished to the sanctioning authority as required under form G.F.R.—12-C.

c. No grant shall be paid to any other institutions/voluntary organizations out of this grant sanctioned by the Government.

d. The Grantee Institution must exercise reasonable economy, observe all financial rules as issued by the Government from time to time while incurring the expenditure.

e. The amount remaining unspent out of this grant shall be refunded back to the Government Treasury by Challan within 3 (three) months from the close of financial year.

f. The amount shall be drawn from the Directorate of Accounts on presentation of the bill in form GAR-32 duly counter signed by the Drawing and Disbursing Officer, Department of Information Technology.

9. *Relaxation and Interpretation of the provision of the Scheme.*— a. The Government through Department of Information Technology, Electronics and Communications shall be empowered to relax/interpret any of the clauses/conditions of this scheme and the decision of the Director (ITE&C) shall be final and binding on all concerned.

10. *Other conditions.*— a. The provisions contained under the scheme shall not be treated as binding representations or assurances on the part of the Government and in the event of non-implementation of any such provisions by the Government, the doctrine of promissory estoppels shall not be applicable against the Government.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the existing Recruitment Rules for the post of Investigator, published vide Government Notification No. 1/13/78-PER (Part file) dated 16/06/2021, in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 13 dated 24/06/2021, the Governor of Goa hereby makes the following rules to regulate the recruitment to the Group 'C', Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial post, in the Directorate of Planning, Statistics and Evaluation, Government of Goa, namely:—

1. *Short title, application and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Goa, Directorate of Planning, Statistics and Evaluation, Group 'C', Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial post, Recruitment Rules, 2026.

(2) They shall apply to the post specified in column (1) of the Schedule to these rules (hereinafter called as the "said Schedule").

(3) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Number, classification and level in the Pay Matrix.*— The number of posts, classification of the said post and the level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule:

Provided that the Government may vary the number of posts specified in column (2) of the said Schedule from time to time subject to exigencies of work.

3. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.*— The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualification.*— No person who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the service:

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where, the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in that regard.

The Department may execute such works after sanctioning the estimate as per the delegation of Technical and Financial powers of Technical Officers of the Department as per the Central Public Works Department (CPWD) Manual in force.”

3. *Insertion of new Rule 6.*— In the Goa Public Lighting Duty Rules, 2021, after rule 5, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—

6. *Source of Funding for Public Lighting Duty Fund (PLDF).*— The amount collected by way of Streetlight Duty Charges under the specific Receipt Head shall be accounted separately in the Estimate of Receipt Head under 0801—05—104—07 and transferred to the fund under 8229—Development and Welfare Funds; 110—Electricity Development Fund; 02—Public Lighting Duty Funds. The Department shall reconcile the revenue collected and transfer the same to PLDF on monthly basis by debiting the same to the Expenditure Head “4801—Capital Outlay on Power Projects; 05—Transmission & Distribution; 001—Direction and Administration; 60—Infrastructure Development for public street lighting; 00—General; 53—Major Works”, by the 15th of the succeeding month. In pursuance of the powers conferred vide Notification No. 2-5-2025-26/GC&EMS/DRS Authority/255 dated 20/05/2026, published in the Official Gazette, Series II No. 9 dated 29/05/2026, and in partial modification of the earlier Notification No. 3-1-2026-27/GDRS/Notification/01 dated 30/06/2026, the Goa Deposit Refund Scheme Authority hereby notifies that Phase I of the Deposit Refund Scheme shall be implemented in the State of Goa with effect from 1st April, 2027, and all Producers, Importers and Brand Owners (PIBOs) dealing in liquor products shall obtain registration under Deposit Refund Scheme on or before 28th February, 2027, as a mandatory precondition for placing such products in the market with effect from 1st April, 2027.
