In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 28 of the Goa Marine Fishing Regulation Act, 1980 (Act No. 3 of 1981) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to further amend the Goa Marine Fishing Regulation Rules, 1982, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Marine Fishing Regulation (Eighth Amendment) Rules, 2026.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Amendment of rule 3.*— In rule 3 of the Goa Marine Fishing Regulation Rules, 1982 (hereinafter referred to as the “principal Rules”),

(I) in sub-rule 3,—

(i) for clause (iii), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“The mechanized fishing vessel shall be fitted with Automatic Identification System (AIS)/Satellite based Transponder/Vessel Tracking and Monitoring System with Search and Rescue Beacon and Very High Frequency Radio Installation set (Marine VHF only), Global Positioning System Navigator and a canoe shall be fitted with a satellite based transponder.”;

(ii) Clause (iv) shall be omitted;

(iii) in Clause (v), after sub-clause (b), the following sub-clause shall be inserted, namely:—

“(c) Every mechanized fishing vessel shall obtain and possess a valid fishing pass for venturing into the sea for the purpose of fishing”;

(II) for sub-rule (7), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“(7) Only registered fishing vessels having valid fishing vessel license shall be allowed to berth at the notified fish landing centre.”

3. *Amendment of rule 4.*— In rule 4 of the principal Rules, after sub-rule (18), the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely:—

“(18 A) The trawl net shall have the square mesh cod end”.

Whereas, cancer constitutes an important public health problem and there is a need for systematic and comprehensive surveillance of cancer incidence, mortality, patterns and trends in the State of Goa;

And whereas, timely collection and reporting of cancer-related information is essential for planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of cancer prevention, early detection, treatment, palliative care and control programmes;

And whereas, the Government of Goa considers it necessary in the public interest to establish a comprehensive and continuing system for notification and surveillance of cancer cases in the State;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 57 of the Goa Public Health Act, 1985 (Act No. 25 of 1985), and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby declares the cancer disease to be a notified disease for the purposes of Part II of the said Act throughout the State of Goa.

1. *Scope of notification.*— All newly diagnosed cancer cases, including in-situ and invasive malignancies, shall be notified to the designated authority in the manner specified by the Directorate of Health Services (DHS).

Such notification shall include, as applicable, cancer cases diagnosed on the basis of histopathology, cytology, haematology, imaging, clinical diagnosis or other accepted diagnostic methods.

2. *Persons and institutions required to notify.*— It shall be the responsibility of every medical practitioner, pathologist, medical establishment and institution diagnosing or treating cancer to notify such cases.

This requirement shall apply to:—

- a) Government hospitals and health institutions;
- b) Government and private medical colleges and teaching hospitals;
- c) Private hospitals, nursing homes and clinics;
- d) Oncology and day-care cancer centres;
- e) Pathology, haematology and cytology laboratories;
- f) Diagnostic and imaging centres;
- g) Hospices and palliative-care institutions;
- h) Health screening and cancer screening programmes; and
- i) Any other healthcare establishment or person as may be specified by the Government from time to time.

3. *Time limit for notification.*— Every newly diagnosed cancer case shall be notified to the designated authority as soon as practicable and preferably within seven days, and in any event not later than one month from the date of diagnosis.

Cancer deaths, where required, shall also be notified in such manner and in such format, as specified by the DHS.

4. *Mode of notification.*— Notification shall be made through the cancer surveillance/cancer registry reporting system as specified by the DHS in such form and such manner as may be specified by the DHS from time to time.

5. *Nodal authority.*— The Chief Medical Officer, Non-Communicable Disease Cell (NCDC) of the DHS shall be the designated authority as well as Nodal Officer for implementation of this notification and he shall designate appropriate State and District-level Officers for receiving, validating and monitoring cancer notifications.

6. *Cancer registry.*— The DHS shall establish or designate a State Cancer Registry/State Cancer Surveillance System for compilation, validation, analysis and monitoring of notified cancer cases in the State of Goa.

7. *Confidentiality.*— All information relating to individual cancer patients received by virtue of this notification shall be treated as confidential and shall be used primarily for public health surveillance, programme planning, research and monitoring.

Only aggregated and appropriately anonymised data shall ordinarily be published or disseminated in accordance with applicable law.

8. *Responsibility of healthcare establishments.*— The heads/in-charge of all Government and private healthcare establishments covered under this notification shall ensure that the notification of cancer cases is carried out by the concerned medical officer, treating physician, pathologist or other authorised person.

9. *Compliance.*— All concerned authorities, healthcare establishments, medical practitioners, laboratories and other stakeholders shall strictly comply with the directions contained in this notification.

Failure to comply with the directions contained in this notification shall be dealt with in accordance with the provisions of the Goa Public Health Act, 1985 (Act No. 25 of 1985) and the rules made thereunder, as applicable.

This notification shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
