Further to the above referred notifications wherein online booking facility for OPDs at Goa Medical College & Hospital was made available to the public for 13 Departments, the Government is now pleased to commence online booking of slots for OPD services for further 7 Departments i.e. Endocrinology-Paediatric, Plastic Surgery, Neurosurgery, Cardiovascular Thoracic Surgery, Geriatric Medicine, Paediatric Surgery, Nephrology with effect from 11-05-2026.

For online booking of OPDs 50 slots per day shall be made available for general public for all of the above departments. Public can avail this online OPD booking facility by visiting the website <https://www.gme.goa.edu.in>

It is re-iterated that booking of online slot shall ensure services at the concerned OPD in GMC based on the availability of doctor on the said date. The facility of doctor specific appointments is yet to be made available through this model.

Further, the offline appointment process for the balance slots shall continue parallelly which can be availed on the same day through existing queue system in GMC. The online booking slots shall be available for the general public for booking for the immediate next 7 days and the booking for the subsequent day shall close on the preceding day at 05:00 PM.

Subject: Grant of Financial Assistance to Economically Weaker Municipal Councils ('C' Class) for strengthening their Administration Scheme, 2026.

The Government of Goa in the interest of 'C' Class Municipal Council is pleased to frame the new scheme for strengthening the Municipal Council administration as follows:

1. *Short title and commencement.*— This scheme may be called “Grant of financial assistance to Economically Weaker 'C' Class Municipal Councils for Strengthening the Administration Scheme, 2026”. It shall come into force with immediate effect.

2. *Introduction.*— (i) While 'A' class and 'B' class municipalities have relatively stronger revenue sources and receive higher grants, 'C' class municipalities operate with limited financial capacity due to their small population base and lack of significant revenue streams.

(ii) Due to their limited income, C-class municipalities heavily depend on State Government grants to meet operational and administrative expenses, including employee salaries. Unlike larger municipalities, these councils operate with minimal resources.

(iii) Currently, only Dearness Allowance (DA) is provided to the employees. Due to these financial limitations, employees of these municipalities are not receiving salary on time and also pension after retirement, despite their service. Delayed salaries and absence of pension benefits leads to financial insecurity for employees.

(iv) Employees of smaller Municipalities perform similar duties to those in larger councils but lack financial security. Providing salaries and pensionary benefits will improve staff morale and ensure livelihood support after retirement.

3. *Objectives.*— The objective of the scheme is to provide full monthly salary to the employees and Pension Benefits for retired employees of C-class municipalities in Goa, ensuring financial stability and parity with employees of A and B-class Municipalities.

4. *Validity of the scheme.*— The scheme shall be valid for the period of five years and shall be revised depending upon financial conditions of 'C' class Municipalities.

5. *Scope of the scheme.*— a. Enhanced social security and dignity of life for retired municipal employees.

b. Improved employee retention and motivation in C-class municipalities.

c. Bridging disparities among different municipal classes.

6. *Eligibility.*— Only 'C' Class Municipal Councils shall be eligible for financial assistance under this scheme. In addition to the grants as sanctioned in point (3) of the scheme, after assessing the merits of the case, Government may sanction additional funds to such weaker 'C' Class Municipal Councils to meet the administrative expenditure on any items in any contingent situation if the Municipal Councils is unable to process/cater due to lack of funds.

7. *Quantum of financial assistance.*— The financial assistance shall be released under the scheme towards salaries and pension to the 'C' Class Municipal Council in two installments.

Grants towards payment of salaries shall be released equivalent to actual monthly salaries of the staff upto the limit of Rs. 50.00 lakhs per annum.

Grants towards payment of pension shall be released equivalent to pensionary benefits of the staff upto the limit of Rs. 25.00 lakhs per annum.

8. *Pattern of Assistance.*— (i) Second installment of salary and Pensionary grants shall be released only upon the submission of utilization certificate of previous installment. If any amount remains unutilized; same shall be adjusted against second release.

(ii) The grants sanctioned under this scheme shall be utilized within a same financial year. However, the Director of Urban Development may extend the time limit in deserving cases.

(iii) The grants shall be utilized solely for the purpose of payment of salaries, and retirement benefits to retired staff of 'C' class Municipal Councils in accordance to the prescribed procedure approved by the Government.

(iv) The Chief Officer shall draw and disburse the grants on receipt of the sanction order from the Director of Urban Development.

(v) The grants sanctioned under the scheme shall also be subject to such other conditions as laid down under the General Financial Rules GFR as amended from time to time.

(vi) A record shall be maintained by the Municipal Councils of the grants released and indicating the amount utilized for the purpose of payment of salaries and retirement benefits.

(vii) The Municipal Councils shall ensure that the salaries and retirement benefits are paid as the norms and guidelines enforce by the Government time to time.

9. *Relaxation.*— The Government may by notification published in Official Gazette modify, alter, add or cancel any conditions of this scheme from time to time.
