#### DELIMITATION COMMISSION

New Delhi, the 19th August, 1963

S. O. 2346.—In pursuance of sub-section (I) of section 10 of the Delimitation Commission Act, 1962 (61 of 1962) as applied by section 43 of the Government of Union Territories Act, 1963 (20 of 1963), the Final Order made by the Delimitation Commission in respect of the Delimitation of parliamentary and assembly constituencies in the Union Territory of Goa, Daman and Diu is hereby published:—

#### FINAL ORDER No. 18

Whereas the proposals of the Delimitation Commission for the devision of the Union Territory of Goa, Daman and Diu into two single-member parliamentary constituencies and for the delimitation of assembly constituencies in that Union Territory were published on the 7th June, 1963, in the Gazette of India and in the official gazette of that Union Territory:

And whereas all the objections and suggestions received were considered at public sittings held at Daman and Panjim on the 7th and 9th August, 1963, respectively:

We hereby determine that the territorial constituencies into which the Union Territory of Goa, Daman and Diu shall be divided for the purpose of elections to (a) the House of the People and (b) the Legislative Assembly of the Union Territory and the extent of each constituency, shall be as shown in the following Tables:—
