In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, read with the Government of India, Ministry of External Affairs Notification No. F.7(11)/62-Goa, dated 25-7-1963, the Lt. Governor of Goa, Daman and Diu is pleased to make the following rules relating to recruitment to Group 'C' Non-ministerial, Non-gazetted posts of Binder and Record Sorter in the Directorate of Accounts, Panaji under the Government of Goa, Daman and Diu.

1. **Short title.**— These rules may be called Government of Goa, Daman and Diu, Directorate of Accounts, Panaji, Group 'C' Non-Ministerial, Non-gazetted posts of Binder and Record Sorter Recruitment Rules, 1981.

2. **Application.**— These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule to these rules.

3. **Number, classification and scales of pay.**— The number of posts, classification of the said posts and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.

4. **Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.**— The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters

connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the aforesaid Schedule.

Provided that,

- (a) the maximum age limit specified in the Schedule in respect of direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and other special categories in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time;
- (b) no male candidate, who has more than one wife living and no female candidate, who has married a person having already a wife living, shall be eligible for appointment, unless the Government, after having been satisfied that there are special grounds for doing so, exempts any such candidate from the operation of this rule;
- (c) *Saving:* Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

5. These rules will come into effect from the date of the Notification and will relate to appointments to the various posts made on or after this date.

Governor of Goa, Daman and Diu is pleased to make the following rules amending the "Government of Goa, Daman and Diu, Directorate of Fisheries, Group 'C' and Group 'D' non-ministerial, non-gazetted posts Recruitment Rules, 1981" issued vide notification No. 1/15/74-PER Vol. III dated 9-2-1981 published in the Official Gazette No. 49, Series I dated 5-3-1981 namely: —

1. *Short title and Commencement.* — i) These rules may be called the Government of Goa, Daman and Diu, Directorate of Fisheries, Group 'C' and Group 'D', non-ministerial, non-gazetted posts Recruitment (First Amendment) Rules 1981.

ii) They shall come into force at once.

2. In the Schedule attached to the said Notification against the post of Assistant Superintendent of Fisheries at Sr. 3, for the existing entry in column 7 substitute:

Essential: —

1. B. Sc. with Zoology/Marine Biology as a subject.

2. Two years training course in Fisheries Science.

OR

M. Sc. with Zoology/Marine Biology as a subject.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Marine Fishing Regulation Act, 1980 (3 of 1981), the Government of Goa, Daman and Diu having regard to need to conserve fish and to regulate fishing on a scientific basis, hereby prohibits fishing with mechanised fishing vessels in the specified area declared as such under Government Notification No. 2-1-81-FSH (iii) dated 7-7-1981.

Explanation: — "Mechanised fishing vessel means a fishing vessel propelled by mechanical means."

O. — In exercise of the powers conferred by rules 5 and 10 of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, and clause (d) of sub-paragraph (1) and sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 17 and paragraph 18 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968, the Election Commission hereby makes the following further amendments in its notification No. 56/79, dated the 28th September, 1979, published as S. O. 557(E) in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II, Section 3(ii), dated the 28th September, 1979, as amended from time to time, which shall be deemed to have been made with effect from the 6th May, 1981: —
